

PTA Board Meeting Minutes

July 11, 2007

The meeting was called to order by President Jo Rogers at 7:35 PM in the Cheyenne County Hospital board room. Jo Rogers, Leisha Hilt, Tammy Church, and Susan Dinkel were present. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Tammy gave the treasurer's report. We have a balance of \$3,022.75. The signature card at the bank had been changed.

Under unfinished business, discussion was held about enrollment and the PTA table. Tammy has asked for the two days off, and Susan will assist her on Thursday, August 9 from 9-2, and Leisha will assist on Friday from 9-2. We moved discussion to the "Back to School Fun Night" to be held on August 24 in conjunction with the soap scrimmage. We left the meeting with the decision being made to see if the teachers would be interested in holding the orientation from 5-6, then move to the high school for the hamburger feed to be held by the booster club, and after the soap scrimmage, continuing with a dance (from approximately 8-11). Tammy volunteered to contact the teachers and see if this would work for them (which was a NO). Therefore, we will have further discussion on this at the next meeting. The PTA programs for the year were discussed. Nothing has been finalized yet, so we will continue discussing this, with Susan, Jo, and Leisha making contacts with some people to see if they would be interested in doing some performances. Finally, discussion was held about donating for the 6th Grade Party. After much discussion, Susan moved and Leisha seconded that we DO NOT donate to the 6th Grade parties, since it only benefits the 6th grade. Motion carried.

Under new business, 2007-2008 committee chairs were discussed. The chairpersons will be finalized at the next meeting, after their agreement to the positions. The PTA handbook was discussed, and no changes will be made for this year. The teacher salad luncheon will be held on August 17. Finally, we discussed corporate memberships. Past-President Lea Keller said that this used to be done and it should be something that we look back into. Tammy is going to contact the state and see what the amount typically is for a membership. Also, it was mentioned that state PTA was going to be held in Salina, April 18-20.

The next meeting will be held on July 31 at 9:00 AM in the Mainstreet Coffee Shop. Susan moved and Leisha seconded that we adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
