

PTA Board Meeting Minutes

July 31, 2007

The meeting was called to order by President Jo Rogers at 9:05 AM in the Main Street Coffee Shop. Jo Rogers, Leisha Hilt, Tammy Church, and Susan Dinkel were present. Minutes of the previous meeting were not read and will be tabled until the next meeting.

No Treasurer's Report was given.

Under unfinished business, the board discussed various presenters for this year. Plans were made for the Teachers Luncheon on August 17 at noon. Jo is going to bring the meat and bread, Tammy drink and salad, Leisha will bring fruit pizza, and Susan will bring a Macaroni Salad. Natalie will be contacted to bring chips and anything else we can think of.

In October, we are planning to have a game night to begin at 7:00. Ideas were to have a 3-legged race, gunny sack races, tug of war, and some other old-fashioned games.

A letter will be sent out to the businesses in town asking if they would like to be corporate members of PTA. The cost of a membership is \$10.00.

Under New Business, the budget will need to be approved. We will take care of that after the teachers luncheon and then a conference call will be made the following Monday at 9:00 PM for final approval.
