

PTA Board Meeting

Conference Call

September 24, 2007 at 9:00 PM

President Jo Rogers called the meeting to order at 9:03 PM. This meeting was held in order to verify prices on gifts and crafts.

Crafts were discussed first. Leisha said that she could get all the crafts needed for approximately \$30, plus \$10 shipping and handling. We felt this was a fair amount and Susan moved, Natalie seconded that we allow her to spend this amount. Motion carried.

In terms of prizes, Tammy had checked at Wal-mart in Colby. Leisha thought they might be a little cheaper in Goodland, so they were going to compare the prices in Goodland. The prizes will be school supplies.

Concessions were then discussed. Tammy said that she was going to visit with the Junior Class to see if they want to do it – we will know soon. If they don't do it, she was going to have the Grade School Yearbook take care of it.

We verified that the cost for the students to get in was going to be \$2.00. The fliers to the parents will go home on Thursday, October 18. Susan is going to create the Flier.

- 2) Teachers DO NOT want a Christmas party because there is always so much going on that day.
