SUBJECT: Sports Physicals for the 2018-2019 School Year

The Cheyenne County Clinic and Health Department will be conducting sports physicals for the **2018-2019 school year** at the Saint Francis Community High School on Monday, May 7, 2018. The physicals will be conducted by Dr. Dallas Walz and Tyler Raile, PA beginning at 7:30 a.m. and will be <u>free of</u> <u>charge</u> - while conducted at the school. If your child does not take part in the "during school" physicals and wants to make an appointment at the clinic, then you will be charged a clinic visit and the physical will be conducted at the clinic.

Students were sent home earlier with the current Pre-Participating Physical Evaluation and Concussion/Head Injury Release forms. Your child must bring all of the forms back to school **COMPLETED and SIGNED** prior to their physical examination on May 7, 2018 - <u>NO EXECEPTIONS!!</u> Your child will not have the examination without the proper signed forms. The Kansas State High School Activities Association handbook states: "No student is eligible to represent any school in interschool athletics, spirit or spirit competition groups until there is on file with superintendent or principal, a statement certifying that the student has passed an adequate physical examination and is physically fit to participate in interschool athletics, spirit or spirit competition groups."
